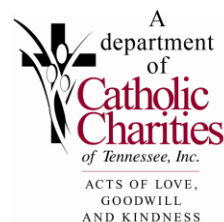
Re: Quarterly report on refugee resettlement for the period October 1, 2020 – December 31, 2020

**Anticipated Arrivals:**

The U.S. Department of State allocates refugees based on where resettlement agencies are located. Resettlement agencies in Chattanooga, Knoxville, Memphis, and Nashville reported a cumulative 424 projected arrivals in FFY 2021. Each resettlement agency's projected arrivals total is approved by their supporting national agency and the Bureau of Population, Refugees, and Migration.
